### Museum Memories

Sloan had its first enterprise in the way of a newspaper in the fall of 1882, when C.C. Hunting started the publication of the Sloan Independent. The venture was short-lived, and the publication soon suspended. The next spring Mr. Hunting attempted to revive the paper, but failed. In the fall of 1883 the publication of the Sloan Star was begun by A.B. Thatcher. Mr. Thatcher had previously established The Era, at Lucky Valley, in the county, but the field and prospects at Sloan appearing more promising, he moved his plant to his place.

The National Society of Collegiate Scholars (NSCS) is a highly selective, national, non-profit honors organization. Founded in 1994, NSCS recognizes first and second year undergraduate students who excel academically.

### Cortner Joins Navy

Malcolm Frantz Cortner of Whiting, Iowa, a 2001 graduate of Westwood High School, recently qualified and enlisted in the United States Navy for guaranteed training in the Navy's Aircrew Program.

Cortner, the son of Malcolm and Patricia Cortner of Sloan, Iowa, will report to Great Lakes, Ill., for active duty in October 2003. There he will undergo basic training to prepare for Navy life.

Upon completion of basic training, Cortner will begin four weeks of schooling in Pensacola, Fla., to prepare for a job in the Navy's Aircrew Program as an Aircrew Rescue Swimmer. Aircrewmembers perform tactical crew duties and in-flight maintenance in jet, turboprop and helicopter aircraft. They also provide rescue of downed pilots with emergency first aid and survival swimming.

Cortner's recruiter said that after successfully completing advanced training, Cortner may go on to additional schooling or be assigned to any one of the Navy's duty stations around the world.

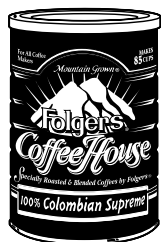

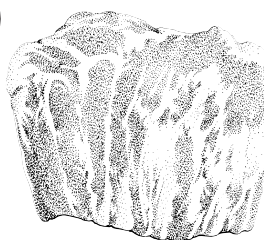

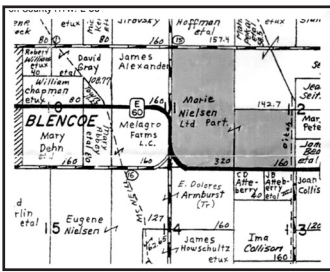

**New Staff at Public Health**

Paula Greene, RN and Judy Johansen, RN, have joined the nursing staff at Monona County Public Health Nursing Service. Their office is in the courthouse annex, phone number (712) 423-1773. They make home visits to assist people with acute or chronic illnesses get the services they need so that they can stay at home. The nurses also suggest ways to prevent disease and promote health.

Paula Greene, RN, MSN, works full-time and is presently assigned to the western part of Monona County (Blencoe,

Onawa, Whiting). She comes to us from the Boston region where she worked for eleven years in cardiac care and intensive care units. In her spare time Paula likes to draw and paint. She enjoys the out of doors and thinks our part of the country is so beautiful.

Judy Johansen, RN, works part-time in the Mapleton, Castana, and Rodney area. Many of you may know Judy from Maple Heights care facility where she worked for nine years as assistant director of nursing. Judy is also an outdoorswoman who has a big garden and yard to care for when she is not doing home visiting.


Anyone can refer clients to Monona County Public Health who need intermittent service due to illness, frailness, or mental or physical disability. One of the agency nurses makes an evaluation as to appropriateness and will

make referrals to other service agencies if needed. Individualized care plans are made with clients and their families to reflect the type of service needed.

Funding for home care services comes from a variety of sources. Medicare will often pay for a short while if the physician orders care for a person who is over 65 years of age, just out of the hospital or has a serious illness, and is homebound. Medicaid will usually pay if there is a physician's order for personal care to someone whose income is at or below the poverty level. For others who do not qualify for Medicare or Medicaid, Monona County Public Health uses a sliding fee scale to determine what the client can comfortably pay for service. The Iowa Department of Public Health provides the agency with some funding to offset the cost of service.

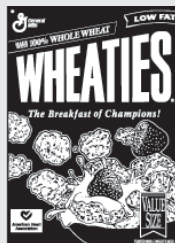

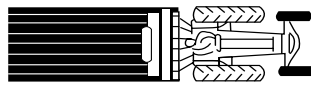

### Volunteers Needed

Iowa State University and the Iowa Department of Natural Resources are surveying four invasive plant species in Iowa woodlands and forests. The goal is to map the distribution and severity of four major invasive plants in the north central United States and increase public awareness about invasive species.

The four species being studied are garlic mustard,

Tartarian honeysuckle, common buckthorn and multiflora rose. The survey will be done on private and public land in Wisconsin, Indiana, Iowa and other north central states.

To conduct a thorough survey, volunteers will be needed. Interested volunteers are asked to attend a free, one-day training session that will cover invasive species identification and data collection methods. A list of the target survey sites in the area will be provided. Two training sessions will be held in July.

July 25, 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. at McFarland Park, Story County, 56461 180th Street, Ames; July 26, 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. at the Mitchell County Nature Center, 18793 Highway 9, Osage.

Researchers will combine all the data collected to produce range and severity maps for each of the four invasive

species and develop an invasive species management plan for the north central region of the United States. The public will have access to the survey results through the project's Web site, various published materials and pre-

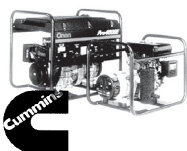

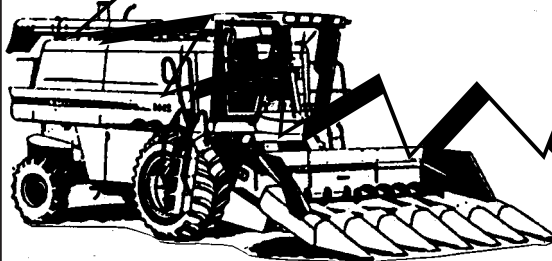
